Here are the details of the forthcoming SKGB Kata Championships. The competition for 2013 will be run as three separate style championships, **WADO-RYU**; **SHOTOKAN**; and **SHITO-RYU**. There will therefore be a Scottish Champion for each category in their respective style. The semi finalists from each category will then go forward to the "All Styles" Championship.

Each style will be responsible for judging their own group and selected judges from each group will then be responsible for the "All Style" finals. **In the team and pairs events all competitors will compete in an all styles category only.**

Entry form available from instructors should be completed and returned with all entry fees of £10.00 per individual, £10 pairs and £15 per team, each team to consist of three competitors. All cheques should be made payable to **The Scottish Karate Governing Body.**
